**STUDENT ABSENCES** - In order to assure your child's safety, please call the school office at 298-4200 if your child is ill or unable to attend school. You can call and leave a message on our 24-hour voice mail if it is before school hours. If your child is not in attendance, and we do not receive a call from you by 9:30 a.m., we will attempt to call you to confirm the reason for the absence. Your phone call saves time for the office and is greatly appreciated!



**LOW INCOME INTERNET ESSENTIALS** - Comcast has a wonderful offer for James Sales families! Families are eligible for a streamlined enrollment process to receive internet access at home. All you need to do is call 1-855-846-8376 or online at [InternetEssentials.com](http://InternetEssentials.com). You will simply need to provide your contact information and the name of your child's school. Upon meeting the eligibility criteria you will receive equipment, device and instructions for set up within 3-5 days. This is such a terrific opportunity for our students and their families! There is so much that students can access online that will help them at school - homework help sites, links to our reading and math programs, just to name a few.

**ATTENDANCE COUNTS!** - Did you know that missing 10% or 18 days - just 2 days a month - in a year can put a student at serious risk of being academically behind? Parents & families are essential partners in promoting good attendance. We don't want you to send your child to school when sick, but we hope you will make every effort to encourage good attendance and make appointments outside the school day whenever possible. Please make sure you call the office if your student is going to be gone from school due to illness or an appointment. Please send in the doctor/dental note the following day to excuse your students' absence. **We have a 24-hour voice-mail you can use to leave messages if you need to call after our school hours.** A call from you is appreciated, as it saves valuable office time.



**MARK YOUR CALENDARS** – Individual pictures will be taken for all James Sales students on Monday, October 19<sup>th</sup>. Picture packets with pricing information is at the end of this newsletter - Please review this. *Pricing is attached to this newsletter.* The envelopes will be sent home the week prior to picture day. *Please keep this envelope handy to send on picture day ONLY (we have very few extras in the office), if you are ordering pictures.* All students will have their picture taken whether you order or not. ## BusBulletin

**Would you like to know when your student's bus is going to be late or what is happening?**

The Transportation Department for Franklin Pierce Schools is now using **Bus Bulletin** notification system to notify parents and schools when there are bus delays and schedule changes.

If you would like to receive instant notifications when delays or incidents affect your student's bus, please register with Bus Bulletin. It is easy and it is free!

- There is **no cost** for this service.
- Registration is simple and fast, online.
- You can choose to receive text messages, phone calls, and/or e-mails.
- You manage your own account and update contact information, securely.
- All contact information is stored securely and will not be shared or sold - your privacy is protected.

### **ATTENDANCE**
