CLEAN HANDS MEAN A HEALTHIER YOU!

WHY? Washing your hands helps keep you from getting sick and spreading disease-causing germs such as colds, flu, and other illness to friends and family.

WHEN?

- ❖ Before eating
- ❖ After using the bathroom.
- ❖ After coughing, sneezing, or blowing your nose.
- ❖ After playing outside.
- ❖ After touching trash.



HOW?

1. **Wet** hands first!
2. **Soap** up!
3. **Wash** for 20 seconds (sing Happy Birthday twice). Scrub tops and bottoms of hands and in between fingers.
4. **Rinse** to wash all those germs down the drain.
5. **DRY!** Wet hands pick up more germs than dry hands.
6. Turn off the water with a paper towel.

Our Goals for 2017-2018

Are your students on target for meeting the attendance and behavior goals at James Sales?
